



## SCHOLARSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Hank Young Foundation will assist with a percentage cost of Rivermount College **student tuition fees only**.
2. The percentage of student tuition fees covered by the Foundation will be subject to an individual review of family income.
3. The cost of all **non-tuition related expenses** at Rivermount College will be the responsibility of parents. Expenses will include items such as:
  - Subject levies
  - All uniforms
  - Textbooks
  - Stationery
  - Families and Friends Levy
  - Student Identification Cards
  - Accident and Insurance charges
  - Specialist Lessons
  - Tours and Camps
4. Applicants in receipt of an Indigenous Scholarship from The Hank Young Foundation are **required** to:
  - i. Adhere to the Code of Behaviour of Rivermount College
  - ii. Participate in the co-curricular activities of Rivermount College, including where applicable, Saturday sport
  - iii. Maintain a satisfactory academic and attendance record for the duration of their enrolment
  - iv. Pay all costs and/or outstanding debts incurred at Rivermount College in a timely manner
  - v. Advise The Hank Young Foundation of any changes to circumstances which may affect the Scholarship (eg. Increase in income)
5. Individual scholarships will be reviewed at regular intervals. Pending the outcome of the review, students not meeting the required performance standards will be asked to show cause as to why the Scholarship should not be withdrawn.
